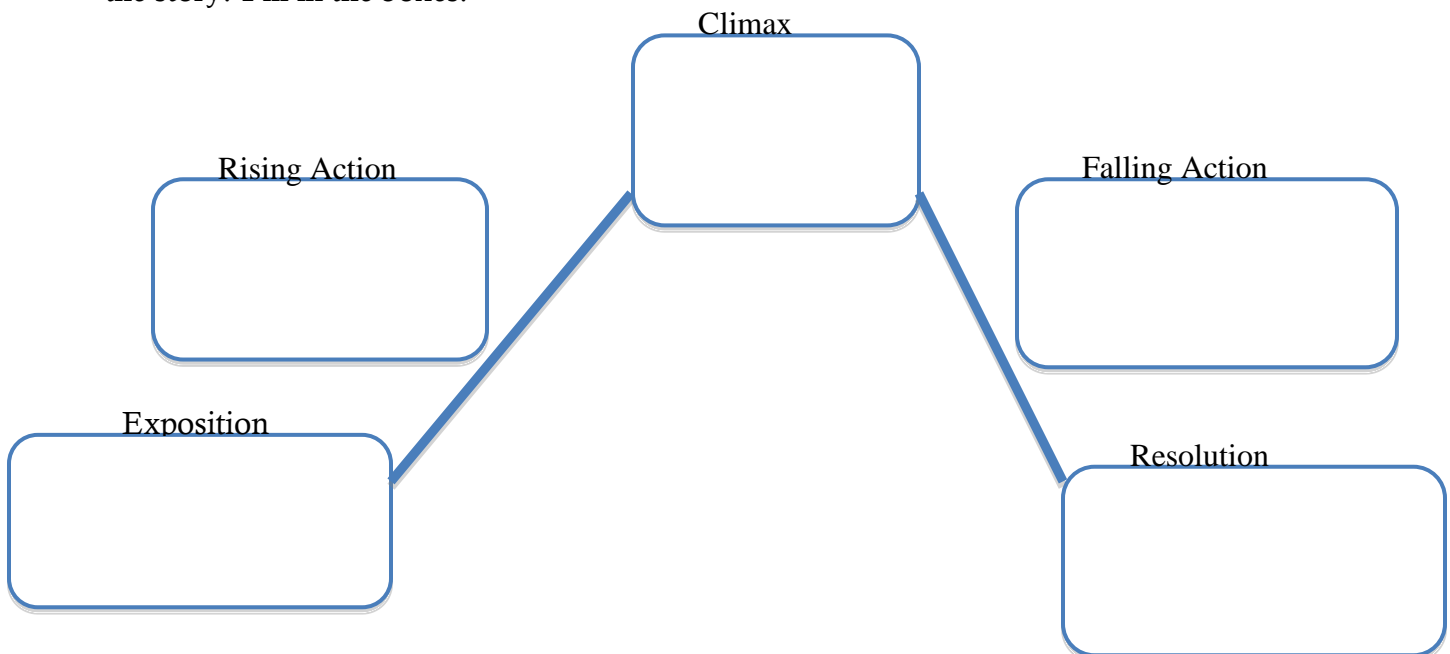
1. **Setting** is the place, time, and environment of the story. What is the setting for this story?
